



IMPORTANT INFORMATION

PGA SENIOR TOURNAMENT MEMBERSHIP

In order to qualify for PGA Senior Tournament Membership, the PGA of Australia conducts the PGA Legends Tour Qualifying School in January each year.

1. All applicants wishing to gain Senior Tournament Membership and a ranking in the relevant PGA Seniors Tournaments Exemption Categories must attend the PGA Legends Tour Qualifying School.
2. Consideration for Senior Tournament Membership may **only** be given to select amateurs in accordance with the Senior Tournament Membership eligibility categories for 2011 following application to, and approval by, the Board of the PGA.
3. All membership applications to the PGA of Australia are reviewed by the Board of the Association. The PGA reserves the right to refuse entry to the PGA Legends Tour Qualifying School or refusal of membership of the organisation to any person who they deem has not acted in a manner consistent with the PGA Membership Regulations.
4. Four (4) Senior Tournament Memberships will be issued in 2011 from the Qualifying School and will be decided by the leading scores over 54-holes stroke play.
5. Senior Tournament Members are required to join the Division of the PGA of Australia in which they have a permanent place of residence.
6. Senior Tournament Members are eligible to enter PGA Legends Tour Events and undersubscribed Divisional Pro-Ams (if invited to do so by the Division staging the event).
7. Senior Tournament Membership is not of itself Full Membership of the PGA of Australia. It is a form of Tournament Membership that allows successful non-members from the PGA Legends Tour Qualifying School access to Legends Events for the 2011 season and the opportunity to earn prize money in order to secure membership and eligibility for the following season.
